CURRICULUM FOR EDUCATION OF STUDENTS FOR THE
TITLE OF HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE DRIVER (V DEGREE)

Brief description of the profession of heavy-duty vehicle driver:

The main goal of the professional development program for the master of heavy motor vehicle drivers is to acquire the necessary knowledge, abilities and skills to work on the most complex jobs performed by a motor vehicle driver. During the realization of the content, it is necessary to cooperate with companies for the transport of passengers and cargo. Part of the content related to the control of technical correctness of vehicles should be performed by visiting the station for technical inspection of vehicles, then safety at work and business of road transport companies should be done by authorized companies or organizations. In the realization of the content, it is very important that participants acquire knowledge related to the proper use of vehicles and regular maintenance in order to contribute to a longer service life of the vehicle and less participation of vehicle costs in the cost of transport. During the classes, the student will be monitored and evaluated. Through monitoring, the teacher will record in the section notes and observations about the student's interest, motivation and abilities. Assessment of participants will be conducted in individual and group forms, orally and in writing. Oral examination will be conducted through oral answers (interview, examination) and questioning.

Objectives of this educational program are to train students:

- to study and research the market of transport services,
- to do rational research of the vehicle fleet,
- to do tasks in the internal traffic control service,
- for jobs in warehouses,
- for jobs in the traffic service at bus and bus stations,
- for jobs regarding regulation, traffic in motion and stationary.

Prerequisite for enrollment:

Candidates for the profession of heavy-duty vehicle driver must have a diploma of the acquired profession of skilled workers and at least two years of practice in the profession.
